

THE PARK SCHOOL (YEOVIL) LTD

ADMISSIONS POLICY

The Park School admits pupils from the age of 3 onwards up to the age of 18 years and beyond. The School is organised as a one form entry Junior and a two form entry Senior school with an additional sixth form.

There is a limit on numbers in the Junior school (up to Year 6) with a normal maximum of 17 pupils allowed per year group. In the Senior school there is a normal maximum of 19 pupils in years 7 to 11 in each class with numbers envisaged to be around 40 maximum in the Sixth Form.

The school admits pupils of all backgrounds regardless of religion, race or ethnic grouping. It provides for a maximum of 28 boarders living on site although there is provision for home-stays. Age 8 is the normal minimum age for boarding.

Entry can be at any age and is by interview accompanied by school report. The school fees are published annually although scholarships are available at 8+, 11+, 13+ and 16+. There are also bursaries available for any child of a parent in full-time Christian work. Additional bursaries for service families and teachers at the Park are also available.
